And Now for the Big Announcements from HRNSW

Sam Nati, CEO, HRNSW announced some fabulous enhancements to the NSW Breeding Industry, the most important of which is for all foals conceived from season 2010 onwards a Breeders Bonus will be payable to the Breeder of that horse on it's first 2yo win and first 3yo win if the said foal is Breeders Challenge eligible. This CASH bonus is in addition to the Statebred Owners Bonus Certificate. Therefore the average owner breeder stands to receive an additional \$3000 cash plus a Statebred Owners Certificate to the value of \$2500 in addition to any prizemoney received for the win. It also means that the breeder who does so to sell, will also receive a cash bonus when that horse wins it's first 2yo & 3yo race. The Bonus is also payable if the horse does not win a bonus as a 2 & 3yo but does win a race as a 4yo. It was also announced that any 2yo, 3yo & 4yo Group 1 winners bred under the above conditions will be eligible for an additional 10% cash bonus to the Breeder.

Other enhancements include an increase in the Statebred Owners bonus to \$2500 which is also payable on the first win as a 2yo & 3yo and if not won at either of these age groups it is also eligible as a 4yo if the horse is Breeders Challenge Eligible.

Mares racing gets a whole lot easier from 1st July with an automatic drop back clause being introduced across the board for all races. The rule states: A mare nominating for any race not already restricted to mares with a front of M1 and faster, TM1 and faster, C1 and faster, T1 and faster or R1 and faster shall be automatically granted a drop back of one class for that race. Lets hope this gets more mares winning races and going on to a career in the breeding barn once their racing career concludes!
